**DECLARATION OF EDMUND J. WOOD  
IN SUPPORT OF MOTION TO  
SUBSTANTIVELY CONSOLIDATE  
CASES**

Edmund J. Wood, the Chapter 7 trustee in the Alen Janisch case (no. 07-15620), hereby joins in the motion made by Michael B. McCarty, the trustee in the Court Reporting Institute case (no. 06-14202) for substantive consolidation of the two cases, and in support, states as follows:

1. The individual chapter 7 case of Alen Janisch was filed on November 23, 2007 by the debtor as a short form filing, consisting solely of the petition and a large list of creditors. Although I have not compared every name, it appears that the list of Mr. Janisch's personal creditors is close to, if not completely identical to, the list of creditors in the Court Reporting Institute case.

As we discussed I have lost communication with Mr. Janisch. I filed an emergency filing for him and he has not provided me with all the documents I need to complete his schedules. I have called him many times. I also visited his house twice and taped a letter to his door on one occasion.

I am not planning on attending the 341 meeting since I have lost communication, he has not given me the information to complete his schedules, or the Rule 4002 documents.

I have not filed a motion to withdraw yet since there are so many creditors. If the case is not dismissed I will file a motion to limit notice to the top 20 creditors and a motion to withdraw.

This case is related to the chapter 7 for Court Reporting Institute, Inc. #06-14202. You may want to discuss it with Mr. McCarty or his attorney Mr. Rigby if you would like more information. Mr. Rigby has filed an adversarial proceeding against Mr. Janisch and others.
